At the same time, it ensures that the renewable raw material does not compete with food supplies.

The cover combines all the advantages of the proven SolarPress technology while reducing the carbon footprint. This innovation is perfectly aligned with Voith's long-standing commitment and ambitious goals of driving sustainability in papermaking and in its own production.

The high stability of the bio-based polyurethane enables use under extreme nip conditions, which in turn enables high machine speeds, increased dry content and reduced energy consumption.


